A **material noun** is the name of a substance or metal of which objects are made.

- **Material Noun** - A material noun is the name of a substance or metal of which objects are made. Material nouns are not countable i.e. they cannot be counted.
Example - Diamond, Gold, Silver, Cotton, Rice, **Mercury**, Sugar, Wool, Wheat, Silk, Milk, etc.
