


## Adverb worksheet for class 4 with answers



### Adverb Worksheet For Class 4 With Answers

Before you read any further, it might be a good idea to first understand [what is an adverb](#)?

In brief, An adverb is a word that tells something more about a verb.

#### Example

He *ran* **fast**

- **Ran** is a verb.
- **Fast** is an adverb.
- **Ran** is a *verb* in the above sentence and **fast** is an *adverb*. The adverb '**fast**' is modifying the verb '**ran**'.
